Chamber of Commerce Signature Events



The Jacksonville•Onslow Chamber of Commerce hosts approximately 14 events each year designed to serve, educate, and connect area businesses, military, and the community. Sponsorship allows members of the Chamber the opportunity to place their brand in front of key decision makers, entrepreneurs, and peers throughout the Jacksonville-Onslow County region. With more than 850 member businesses, an e-mail list of more than 1,000 professionals, and an active social media presence of over 12,000 followers, your business will get noticed as a sponsor of a Chamber event and recognition as an active participant in the Chamber and business community.

Hispanic Heritage Month Vendor Fair

The Jacksonville Onslow Chamber of Commerce Business Diversity Council (JOCOC BDC) hosts a Hispanic – Latino Business Vendor Fair held at Kimbrell's Furniture Parking Lot every September. This event showcases the Hispanic – Latino business and arts culture with vendors, food, and dance.

Minority Enterprise Development Day

During Minority Enterprise Development Day, The Diverse Entrepreneur of the Year and the Linda L. Richardson Minority Business Advocate of the Year are recognized at a special Awards Luncheon Ceremony.

Oysterfest

The Oysterfest is a popular networking event exclusively for Chamber Members. Along with feasting on local oysters, attendees can sample the culinary skills of local restaurants.

Christmas Holiday Parade

Every year, approximately 15,000 spectators from around Onslow County line the streets in downtown Jacksonville to enjoy this festive parade. This is an annual tradition in the Jacksonville community, and for many, the parade is recognized as the start of the holiday season. The parade begins at Coastal Carolina Community College and ends at the Brynn Marr Shopping Center. This event is broadcasted live on WITN Channel 7 and it will be replayed again the Sunday after Thanksgiving.

Black History Month

In celebration of Black History Month, the Jacksonville Onslow Chamber of Commerce Business Diversity Council (JOCOC BDC) will provide a three-day event:

- **Professional Development Day**: A learning day for business professionals and their employees. Continuing education platforms are a great way to develop employee skills, boost morale and improve recruitment efforts. Keynote speakers will provide training on topics that will help grow a professional and thriving work environment.
- Black History Month Networking Mingle: The network mingle is a fun, relaxed atmosphere to connect with fellow community members and celebrate Black History Month with good cuisine and fellowship.
- African American Heritage Trail Tour: The event begins with lunch, and a presentation at the Jacksonville Onslow Chamber of Commerce, followed by a tour of a few hand- picked trail markers to show the history and accomplishments of local African American leaders, communities, history, arts, and culture.

Annual Membership Celebration



Women's History Month Networking Mingle

The Jacksonville Onslow Chamber of Commerce Business Diversity Council (JOCOC BDC) hosts a Women's History Month Networking Mingle every March. The mingle is a relaxed environment to network with local entrepreneurs, as well as fellow Chamber members, to celebrate Women's History Month.

Trades Day

The Jacksonville•Onslow Chamber of Commerce partners with Coastal Carolina Community College to host this annual competition for vocation-focused high school students in Onslow and Jones County High Schools. Trades Day recognizes over 125 students for their talents. With the generosity of local businesses, students celebrate their progress in learning skilled trades with new tools and other practical gifts.



Administrative Professional Breakfast

The Annual Administrative Professionals' Celebration sheds light on the many contributions of the devoted and valued administrative professional. This is a great opportunity for management to honor an administrative staff member by treating them to a breakfast and an entertaining program in recognition of the valuable contributions and positive impact they have in our community. Nominations are accepted from all businesses in Onslow County and approximately 20 administrative professionals are recognized at the Celebration. One nominee is selected as the Administrative Professional of the Year.

Small Business Week and Breakfast

Small Business Week recognizes the important impact small businesses have on the economy. During this week, the Chamber partners with the Coastal Carolina Community College Small Business Center to host seminars that provide entrepreneurs and small businesses the opportunity to gain insightful information to help them be successful. Additionally, the Chamber hosts the Small Business Week Awards Breakfast. At this event, Duke Energy Citizen & Service Award as well as the First Citizen's Bank Small Business of the Year Award are presented.



Each year the Jacksonville•Onslow Chamber of Commerce presents the State of the Community Address. The program provides attendees with a brief explanation of what took place in the past, what is currently happening and what the future holds for Onslow County. A panel is comprised of representatives in the following areas - economic development, healthcare, education, military, and local government. This event highlights the positive impact of collaborative partnerships between the Chamber and other community organizations. This event is recorded and broadcasted through Jacksonville's local television and is available online.
